This is the truth. Peace be with you

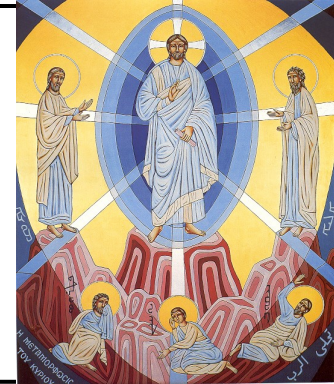
